



Taking personal and collective action


Using critical thinking **skills** to create place-based solutions

**Attitudes** of appreciation and concern for the environment and inspiration to act with the environment in mind

Deeper knowledge of natural systems and processes

General **awareness** of the relationship between the environment and our choices



## Background


- Survey created by Alberta Water Council's Water Literacy Project Team
- Initially delivered by phone to 100 individuals across the province in 2015
- Put online for 2016/17, 2017/18 and 2018/19
- Survey was distributed through AEP social media accounts, WPACs, non-profit organizations, at tradeshows & events





## Who's taking the survey?


- As of April 11, 2018:
  - Fully completed by 408
  - Partially completed by 860
- In 2017, had 97% new respondents








A watershed (or drainage basin) includes all of the land that water flows across as it drains toward a common body of water, such as a stream, river, lake or coast. Do you live in a watershed?








#### In comparison to other provinces like British Columbia and Ontario, would you say Alberta has a lower, equal or higher number of recreational lakes.






## Which of the following are types of wetlands?


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## All naturally occurring water in Alberta belongs to the Crown (Government of Alberta).






Any activity that will result in the loss of wetland area (such as draining for agricultural, industrial or residential use) in Alberta must first be authorized by the Government of Alberta.






Which of the following statements do you believe to be true about Alberta groundwater (underground water found in the aquifer)? (Choose all that are true.)






#### I believe the biggest threat of contamination to Alberta's groundwater is: (Choose one.)






## Who should have the most responsibility for ensuring Alberta lakes are healthy?








#### Which of the following wetlands activities have you done in the last 12 months? (Choose all that apply)


