Looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person to join the Mighty Peace Watershed Alliance for a full-time Watershed Education & Outreach position to lead a variety of watershed education, engagement, and outreach activities for adults and youth across the Peace Watershed. Activities could include but not limited to workshops, tradeshows, presentations, demonstration site visits, project tours, newsletters and social media. Audience will include school groups, decision makers, stakeholders, and the public. There will also be some aquatic monitoring activities. Position to Start Mid – late October. Skills & knowledge required: excellent written and verbal communication, experience and understanding effective learning activities, self motivated, effective at independent and teamwork, solid science understanding, experience with planning processes and project management and report writing, work with a variety of stakeholders, working in a not-for-profit environment with multi-sector participants, Comfortable working in outdoor situations, ability to present material in an effective educational way, ability to travel across the watershed as required, must have a valid driver's licence and vehicle. Knowledge of the Peace/Slave Watersheds and the Government of Alberta's Water For Life Strategy would be an asset. <u>Education and Experience level:</u> Post secondary education in an Environmental science, Biology, Geography, Agriculture, Land Reclamation or related discipline. Work experience in providing education/outreach activities to a varied audience is essential.

If you are looking for an opportunity to experience a variety of projects, planning initiatives, education delivery events and engaging with stakeholders from across the watershed – this may be a career for you!

This position is based out of McLennan, AB. Relocating to a MD of Smoky River community would be preferred – services in the area include schools (bilingual opportunities), hospital, recreation facilities, youth sports teams & organizations, community Libraries, work opportunities for partners, and basic shopping needs (with larger centre of Peace River within 45 mins).
